





- Read a minimum of 3 books during the programme.
- Enter their challenge information in the reading log.
- Each participant can read any book of their choice (this booklet provides reading suggestions only).
- Every child that completes the requirements above will receive a prize, however to be eligible for the top prizes participants are now required to write a summary of their favorite book.

To be Eligible for Top Prizes:

- 1) Choose one of the books you read from your list that was your favorite.
 - 2) Write a brief summary stating why it's your favorite book.
 - 3) The summary must be 50 words or less.

All students reading the recommended hours per week, completing the number of required age appropriate books and completing the book summary will be entered into a drawing for prizes!


